As architects, we take pride in being creative and technically well informed about the built environment. However, our fraternity often tends to sideline the humane aspect of architecture that deals with intangible aspects such as memory, power, emotions, cooperation, and a sense of justice. They merely act as a minuscule part of the initial study during the process of any architectural design. This problem draws its roots from our educational system as we pay very little attention to the subjects related to social sciences (such as history, political science, cultural studies, conflict studies, anthropology, administrative studies, etc.) in our architecture education. Generally, the credits and weightage given to these subjects in our curriculum are less than one-fifth of the total. Therefore, it is essential to (re)introduce this social science-related approach in our architectural education affirmatively.

The proposed TTP aims to address this gap in our architectural education by highlighting the need and urgency of the social science approach for the future generation of architects. It does so by providing key insides on a current trend of global interdisciplinary architectural practice, social ethics and morals that architects can embrace while designing and providing a methodology for integrating the social science approach in architectural education. The proposed TTP will help the academicians to strengthen the importance and necessity of a social science approach, increase the understanding of few critical areas of study within social sciences, and provide a methodology to incorporate the humane approach in architectural education.
