### About the STTP:

The past two decades have seen an exponential rise of liveability measures. Reflecting increased urbanity globally, they risk making the notion of the city ever more contested. When we consider the liveability of cities then, it is clear we are dealing with a plethora of issues – both isolated and, inevitably, interconnected.
