Sub.:—Admission into 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. degree and 2-year M.Arch. degree course at institutions approved by the Council for the academic session 2022-2023— reg.

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the Council of Architecture, a Statutory Body of the Government of India, regulates the Architectural Education throughout the country under the provisions of the Architects Act, 1972.

The Council has been receiving request from institutions to extend the last date for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. and 2-year M.Arch. degree courses due to delay in admission process by various admission authorities in the country for the academic session 2022-2023, owing to several factors.

In view of the same, the Council of Architecture, in order to ensure smooth admission process, continuation of academic activities, conduct of the examinations and declaration of results, has decided that the admissions to the first year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course at architectural institutions for the session 2022-23 may be completed by **October 30, 2022** and the classes for Architecture course may commence from **November 1, 2022**. A revised academic calendar prescribed by the Council is also attached for your kind perusal and necessary action.

The reservation of seats for admission into 1<sup>st</sup> year of B.Arch./M.Arch. course shall be as per the policy of Central Government or the respective State Governments.

All the admission authorities, institutions and universities imparting B.Arch. course in the country are requested to take note of the above while granting admission to students into the said courses.
